INTRODUCTION



- Students are measured in knowledge and skills, as well as readiness for the next level of study.
- Fourth grade teachers will gain a better understanding of your child's level. Results will be used to identify additional support or a need for more challenging work.
- This information is also used to measure how well schools and districts are helping students achieve higher expectations.
- For the 2019-2020 school year, students will take tests in:
 - English language arts (ELA)
 - Mathematics
 - Social Studies
 - Science

ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS



- Three different sessions (Monday/Tuesday/Wednesday).
- **Monday and Tuesday-** The students will read passages, answer multiple choice questions for each, then write an essay using evidence from both passages.
- Writing will be either Literary Analysis, Informational, or Narrative
- **Wednesday-** the students will read passages (literature and informational texts) and answer multiple choice questions for each.

PREP FOR ELA SECTION



- Great teaching all year long!
- Reading tests have been following the format students will see (questions with part A/B).
- Encourage students to go back into text to find answers then eliminate answers using testing strategies
- Break apart the writing prompt. All year we teach a variety of writings and self editing to prepare.

MATH



- Three different sessions (Monday/Tuesday/Wednesday).
- Types of questions:
 - Multiple choice. Some have two or 3 answers.
 - Word problems asking students to explain how answer was found.
 - Error analysis questions

PREP FOR MATH SECTION



- Great teaching all year long!
- Weekly tests have 2-step word problems.
- Eliminating answers.
- Different strategies for each skill.
- Encourage students to work out each answer choice in multiple choice questions (remind to stay away from bubbles).
- Pay close attention when asked to choose more than one correct answer.
- Moby Max review and fluency

SOCIAL STUDIES



- Focused on Louisiana history and culture
- Two sessions that involve students reading several sources, then answering multiple choice questions.
- Differences:
 - Session 1: general social studies skills and knowledge multiple choice.
 - Session 2: general social studies skills and knowledge multiple choice. Short Answer response.

SCIENCE



- Two sessions focused on item sets and stand alone items
- Consists of multiple choice and an essay

HOW CAN YOU HELP YOUR CHILD?



- Good night sleep
- Healthy breakfast and snack
- Be at school every day and on time
- Encouragement and positive attitude!
- Make-ups are not easy to get (doctors note).

- This is NOT a high-stakes test!

TEST RESULTS



- Schools and school systems will receive individual student Spring 2020 LEAP results for ELA and Math by July. Each school system will decide how to share this information with teachers, parents, and students.
- We received last years scores in July/August.
- Student scores are loaded in JPAMS for parents to review.
