

School may look a little different this year at Magnolia Trace Elementary. . .

Let the Adventure Begin!

While our school year may look a little different this year, we are excited to see our students back on campus! We will implement several procedures and health safety measures to promote a safe and healthy environment for all.

Arrival by Bus or Car	 <u>Bus</u> – Students will exit the bus 6 feet apart <u>Cars</u> – Cars should enter the gate on Viola, pass in front of Lake Harbor, and turn right into the MTE car line.
When a student exits the car or bus	 Students will exit buses in the bus loop on the side of the school, and cars in the car loop in the front of the school. Students will stop at the hand sanitizer cart and sanitize their hands. Students will walk, socially distanced, 6 feet apart to their classrooms. Adults will be in the hallways to assist students and say, "Good morning."
Breakfast	 Grab and Go meal breakfast will be available to the students. Students will eat breakfast in/near their classroom.
Health Screening	 The student's teacher will health screen the students prior to entering the classroom by completing the following: taking the temperature, asking the health screening questions.
Hand Washing & Hand Sanitizing	 ALL MTE classrooms have sinks. Students will wash their hands when they arrive in class, many times throughout the day, no less that every 2 hours, before/after lunch, before/after recess, before/after shared use of shared computers, and before dismissal. Hand sanitizer is also available in all classrooms for student use.
Lunch	 Each class will eat lunch together, as a class, in their assigned lunch classroom. The students will wash their hands before/after lunch. The eating areas will be sanitized before/after each lunch.
Recess	 Each class will have recess together as a class. Each class has an assigned recess time during the school day. Recess equipment will be sanitized before/after each recess time.
Dismissal	 Students will remain in their classrooms during dismissal until their car name or bus number is called. Cars should enter the Viola gate and line up in front of Lake Harbor. Buses will be loaded using social distancing practices.
Mask & Static Groups	 Mask are required for all employees and 3rd grade students 2nd graders are encouraged, but not required, to wear mask. Our classes will remain with the same "static group" of students throughout the day to the greatest extent possible.
Visitors & Parents	 Only essential personnel are allowed on the school campus, visitors are not allowed. When checking out a student, please call the school office when you arrive and someone will meet you out front.
Illness and Absences	 If your child is sick or has a fever, please keep them home. We will work with you to provide make-up work.
